March Green Tip March is the time to have your flower beds prepared for spring planting. From our March 3rd workshop you have learned about the different types of mulches and fertilizers available. Your beds should be designed on paper first to avoid repositioning of delicate plants later. Start with a good soil conditioner and mix with 2/3 of ground soil for best results. Now is the time to plant perennials, trees and shrubs. To avoid a late frost, plant summer vegetables and annuals after April 15th.
